ACADEMIC REGULATIONS APPLYING TO VISITING STUDENTS

Classification Students permitted to enroll as Visiting Students at Trinity are not considered enrolled, or matriculated, into a degree program. Visiting Students are restricted to taking an academic load of no more than eight credit hours (8) per academic term. Such students are allowed to take no more than one course per session of summer school.

Alternative Classifications:

- **Auditors:** Individuals auditing courses do not receive academic credit. Auditors are **not** required to complete a visiting student application. However, they need to complete a form at the time of registration. No application materials or transcripts are required.
- **Regular Students:** Individuals classified as Regular Students have submitted complete application materials and have been formally admitted to Trinity.

Changing from Visiting Student Status to Regular Student Status Submit completed application materials for the degree program that you are interested in pursuing. Please refer to the current catalog regarding residency requirements for each program.

Registration Visiting Student Registration Visiting Students must be fully registered before attending classes. Designated registration times specifically for Visiting Students are announced each academic term at Trinity. Visiting Students who complete registration after these designated times will be billed a \$20.00 Late Registration Fee.

Payment Due at time of registration.

Official Transcripts An official transcript of your Trinity coursework will be sent only upon your request and if an official final undergraduate transcript is on file. Official transcripts cannot be issued directly to the student, but a copy of your grades will be available upon request.

Academic Calendar Dates for the beginning and end of each academic term, final examination periods, vacation periods, and deadlines for dropping and adding courses are found in the current catalog.

Refunds, Withdrawals, and Changes-In-Registration Standard forms and procedures are required and specific deadlines apply to Visiting Students including changes from enrollment on a credit basis to enrollment on an audit basis. Check the current catalog or inquire at the Records Office for details.

Miscellaneous Items

- No academic advisor is assigned to those enrolled as Visiting Students. For counsel, such students should contact the Records and Admissions Offices.
- Student identification cards are not usually issued to Visiting Students.
- Campus mailboxes are not usually assigned to Visiting Students. Visiting Students are, however, responsible for notices in the News and Notes, the weekly newspaper for the Divinity and Graduate Schools. They are available across from the student mail boxes.

Master's Program Rebate Benefits for Part-time Students Visiting students are encouraged to acquaint themselves with the various programs that offer rebates and discounts for part-time students. These include rebates for EFCA Pastors, others engaged in Full-Time Ministry, Campus Ministries, and Spousal Rebates and others.
