Certificate of Finance Form

This form must be completed by every international student seeking admission to Trinity International University. In order for a certificate of eligibility I-20 form to be issued, the US government requires Trinity International University to check whether every student has adequate funds to cover academic and living expenses while attending Trinity.

Please keep in mind that US government regulations prohibits international students on an F-1 visa to work off-campus except when there is a severe and unforeseen economic hardship. Moreover, while students on F-1 visas are permitted to work on-campus, on-campus jobs are scarce. Also, dependents are not allowed to work under any circumstances.

Please make a copy of this document and all other supporting documents. You will be required to present these documents at the U.S. embassy or consulate when you apply for the F-1 visa and F-2 visa for your dependents.
