General Education Recommendations: College of DuPage/TIU REACH

Note: TIU does not participate in the IAI.

Transfer students must follow the general education requirements listed below.

Psychology	3	Choose one from PSY 1100, PSY 2233, PSY 2235, PSY 2237
Biblical Studies	6	Normally taken at TIU (No COD equivalent)
Foundations of Adult Learning	3	Met through TIU (No COD equivalent)

- A maximum of 64 hours will be accepted in transfer from a community college. Please note any courses that are also in the student's TIU major will not transfer.
- Students must receive a "C" grade or higher per course. Each course will be assessed prior to transfer.

TIU REACH Admissions Requirements

- Minimum 23 years of Age
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- At least two years of significant work experience. (Experience other than paid work, such as volunteer activity or parenting, may be considered toward meeting this requirement)
- Two Character Recommendations assessing professional abilities, character, and capacity for university-level study

Organizational Leadership Major: This major prepares students to advance to leadership rolls in their chosen profession through the development of communication, organizational and analytical skills. This degree can be tailored to meet individual career goals and merges practical with theoretical study. Individuals in business, social service and healthcare can all find it equally practical. Throughout the major, students are encouraged to bring insights from experience into the classroom and to apply learning from the classroom to their workplace. Students will also be well prepared for graduate studies in various fields. This program takes approximately 18 months to complete. *Please note, all the courses in the Organizational Leadership Major must be taken at TIU. Any courses in the major taken at another institution will not transfer.*

Christian Ministry Major: This major is designed for individuals currently involved in some type of ministry, either professionally or in a volunteer capacity. It is formulated for the working pastor in mind but relevant for anyone who wishes to serve in the church more effectively. Students will also be well prepared for graduate studies in MAT and MAR. This cohort takes approximately 20 months to complete. *Please not, all the courses in the Christian Ministries Major must be taken at TIU. Any courses in the major taken at another institution will not transfer.*
