Vital Statistics – Fall 2020

In May of 2020, there were 11 graduates of TED's MA in Mental Health Counseling program. Our graduates consistently achieve high pass rates on licensing examinations. The pass rate for graduates taking the NCE examination in the spring of 2020 was 100%.

There are currently 83 students enrolled in the mental health counseling program at TEDS. Of that number, 63 are female and 20 are male; 50 are Caucasian and 33 are students of color. While our program accommodates both part-time and full-time students, approximately 75% of our students graduate in the projected time period: three years for full-time students.

Graduates of our MA in MHC go on to work in a variety of settings, such as private practices, social service agencies, hospitals, and college counseling centers. Some of our graduates move directly into doctoral programs; others defer the job search due to other career opportunities, geographical moves, and/or responsibilities related to family life. Of the students who actively seek employment upon completion of the program, 95% of them secure positions in the field of mental healthcare.
