Note: These ratios were calculated using a formula that began with determining the number of credits offered in the semester. This number was divided by the university defined full-time teaching load (9 credits per semester). This number was used as the Faculty FTE.

Next, the number of student credit hours produced in the same courses used in determining Faculty FTE was calculated (number of students enrolled in the courses). This total credit number was divided by the university defined full-time student number. This produced the Student FTE.

Finally, the FTE student number was divided by the FTE faculty number to produce the faculty to student ratio.

Faculty FTE = Credits Offered / University Defined Teaching Load *University Defined Teaching Load = 9 hours

Student FTE = Student Credit Hours Produced / University Defined Full Time Student Load
