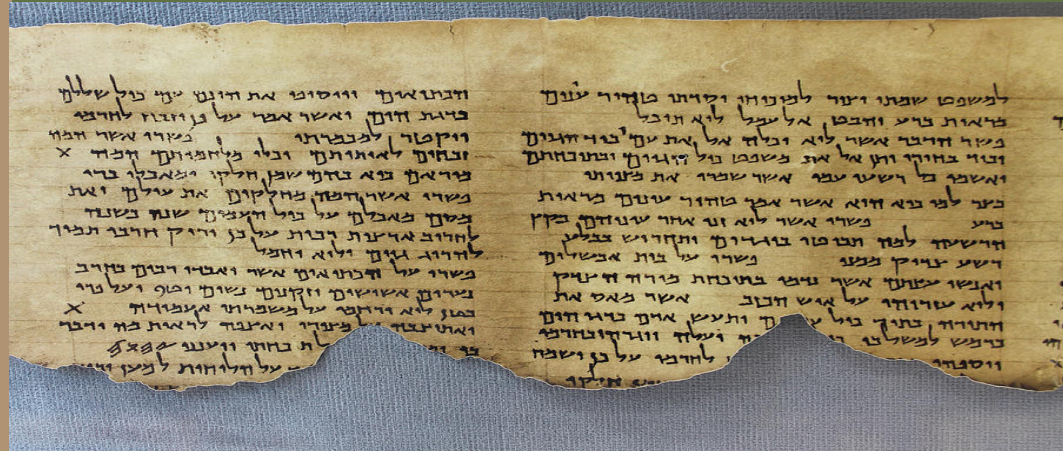

Carol Meyers, the Mary Grace Wilson Professor Emerita of Religious Studies at Duke University, specializes in biblical studies, archaeology, and gender in the biblical world. A prolific scholar, she is the author of more than 450 articles, reports, reference-book entries, and reviews; and she has authored, co-authored, or edited twenty-three books, including *Rediscovering Eve: Ancient Israelite Women in Context*. She has co-directed several of Duke's archaeological projects in Galilee and has been a frequent consultant for media

productions dealing with the biblical world. She recently served as President of the Society of Biblical Literature and Vice-President of the Albright Institute of Archaeological Research in Jerusalem, and she is a trustee of the American Society of Overseas Research and the Dead Sea Scrolls Foundation.
