



Title II Information

During the 2016-2017 reporting year (reported to the Federal government April 30, 2018), 28 candidates completed an approved initial licensure program at Trinity International University and were recommended by entitlement to the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) for initial teacher licensure. These 28 candidates completed their semester of clinical practice (student teaching) with an average of 560 clock hours of student teaching in their placement classroom. Nine faculty members supervised the student teachers, including one full time faculty member and eight part-time faculty members. A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 is required of undergraduates to complete the program; graduate students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0. The median GPA of undergraduate completers was 3.59; the median GPA was 3.85 for graduate completers. Candidates are also required to pass the edTPA, a teacher performance assessment that is nationally scored. All 28 candidates passed the edTPA (100% pass rate).

Admission to the teacher education programs of the Division of Education at Trinity International University requires a minimum GPA of 2.5 for undergraduates and 3.0 for graduate students. The median GPA of admitted undergraduate students was 3.76; it was 3.96 for graduate students.

Prior to student teaching, candidates must pass a statewide content-area test. One hundred per cent of Trinity candidates passed the content test; the statewide pass rate for the content tests is 100%.
